Main responsibilities:

Development of designed research project about EU foreign policy in the region;

Recruitment of external researchers to be employed in specific research projects;

Supervise preparation of papers by external researches and review and edit these papers;

Coordination of a research unit dedicated to ongoing research about the abovementioned region;

Undertaking individual publications on the aforementioned issues;

Establishing and maintaining professional contacts with key external organizations and individuals.

Proven experience in academic research and/or policy evaluation;

Prior knowledge and skills:

Fluency in English, both written and orally; Good use of Excel and Word;
Good use of STATA, Python, GIS and/or R is a plus;
Hebrew and Arabic is a plus;
French is a plus.

Profile:

The successful candidate must show effective communication and writing skills, ability to cooperate and to manage other researchers, ability to meet tight deadlines, and scientific rigor.
