Sine Qua Non is a think tank advocating for a coherent European foreign policy in the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region. Founded in Paris in 2018 by researchers and young professionals, it draws from backgrounds and experiences from all over the European continent, the MENA region and beyond.

Sine Qua Non's main publications are policy briefs, analysis reports and case study publications. Its first case study deals with rethinking European foreign policy in Israel and the occupied Palestinian territory (oPt). Currently, the research unit dedicated to the first case study counts on more than 17 researchers from different academic background. In the meantime, Sine Qua Non has published three analysis reports, one policy brief, five op-eds and six podcasts. In 2020 Sine Qua Non plans to launch three other geographic and thematic case studies, as well as many other projects that will be disclosed throughout the year.

Description of the position:

Sine Qua Non is looking for a Legal Officer.

Responsibilities will include:

- Drafting contracts for SQN's researchers and liaising with them;
- Overview the legal terms of SQN's partnerships with other institutions;
- Contribute to SQN's professionalization strategy.

The legal officer will be under the direct responsibility of the President, and most activities will be fulfilled in collaboration with the relevant staff. However, the successful candidate should be able to work independently and report their advancements on a bi-weekly basis. The position requires on average **5h of work per week**.

Sine Qua Non is looking for a highly motivated young professional, willing to join a committed and diverse working environment. Rigorousness, ability to think critically, and respect for deadlines are paramount requirements for this position.

Requirements include:

- Actively undergoing a **degree in Law**
- Proven knowledge of French *Droit des contrats*, *Droit des sociétés* and *Droit de la propriété intellectuelle*
- Fluency in English and French
- Proven interest in European foreign policy and in the MENA is a plus
- Proven former experience as legal officer/intern is a plus
